#### **Enmity**

"Declaring war between you and the woman, between your offspring and hers." Gen 3:15 msg

Woman becomes the focus of the enemies attack to stop, divert and pollute the Seed of the divinely begotten future Messiah. The fall and redemption of man comes through a woman.

"Yet your desire and craving will be for your husband, and he will rule over you" Gen 3:15 amp

God changes the order. Women are submitted to husbands as their covering as a (servant) leader.

"Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her to make her holy, cleansing her by the washing with water through the word". Eph. 5:25–26 NIV

# **The Blessing of Submission**

We are submitted to each other

Eph. 5:22 "Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is **head** of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church: and He is the Savior of the body. Therefore, just as the church is subject to Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in everything."

**Head** - Hebrew root 'rosh' = head of a line, supreme; first, top, prince of the highest part, summit, foremost, leader and chief.

Col. 3:18 "Wives submit to your own husbands, as is fitting in the Lord."

TREAD ON SATAN'S HEAD

1Peter 3:1 "Wives, likewise, be submissive to your own husbands, that even if some do not obey the word, they, with out a word, may be won by the conduct of their wives,"

Be good wives responsive to our husband's needs. Wives, understand and support your husbands by submitting to them in ways that honor the Master. Wives, understand and support your husbands in ways that show your support for Christ. The husband provides leadership to the his wife the way Christ does to His church, not by domineering but by cherishing. So just as he submits to Christ as he exercises such leadership, wives should likewise submit to their husbands.

#### Submitting to one another is key to successful relationships.

**Submit** - In Hebrew = Hypotasso - to arrange under, to subordinate, to subject, put in subjection, to subject one's self, obey, to submit to on's control, to yield to ones admonition or advice, to obey, be subject

1 Peter 5:5 "Likewise you younger people, submit yourselves to your elders. Yes, all of you be submissive to one another, and be clothed with humility, for God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."

Submitting to one another is key to successful relationships. It keeps us humble. As we submit to God we submit to others laying ego aside and our children follow suit.

All rightful authority is derived from God; therefore to submit to authority honors God. Submission is an act of faith. The higher the authority, the greater the accountability to God.

God designed marriage to illustrate the relationship He intends to have with His people. The husband is to give his wife honor and understanding, protecting her and acknowledging that she is fully partnered heir of God. The wife is to accept the care and authority of the husband, living in a manner that honors him. The beauty of character and gentleness of spirit of such a woman will be precious to God and to her husband.<sup>1</sup>

It is an act of faith to submit to those put in authority over us, recognizing that God is the ultimate authority over
